

“Dark Honeymoon” for Alpine Pictures

Hollywood, CA (March 17, 2006) – Alpine Pictures’ Ryan Carroll, Neil Kaufman and Rene Torres will executive produce the upcoming thriller “Dark Honeymoon,” written and directed by David O’Malley (*Fatal Instinct*) and produced by Michael T. Meltzer (*The Hidden*).

Principal Photography begins in May 2006 on the thriller, a suspenseful tale of obsession and manipulation about a man who marries a seductive woman after a brief and passionate relationship. But during their honeymoon on the fog-shrouded Oregon coast, he learns the terrible truth about her as those around them begin to die mysterious and violent deaths. Shooting will be in Southern California.

Cast includes Oscar nominated actors Daryl Hannah (*Kill Bill Vol. I and II*), Roy Scheider (*All That Jazz*) and Eric Roberts (*Runaway Train*) along with Sean Young (*No Way Out*).

“Dark Honeymoon” is Hannah’s second production with Alpine Pictures. She recently starred in Alpine’s “Love Is the Drug,” a teen dramatic thriller which premiered to rave reviews in Park City earlier this year.

Prior to forming Alpine Pictures, Ryan and Roland Carroll created their first feature film, “Witchboard” which grossed over \$30m. After that initial success, the brothers reunited in 1995 to form Alpine Pictures, which would go on to produce many other successful projects including “The Convent” which debuted at the Sundance Film Festival. The company has since expanded to the area of international distribution and has recently begun to include domestic distribution in order to capitalize on the huge international market seeking distribution in the United States and to enhance co-production deals with international production companies.

Alpine Pictures, Inc. currently includes film and television production and distribution to all markets including theatrical, cable, broadcast and home video (DVD). The company is also expanding into the highly profitable area of new media such as internet and vodcast.

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
